

Street Law Driving School Policies Regarding Examinations

1. The fee for the Knowledge exam is \$30.
2. The fee for the Skills exam is \$80.
3. The fee for a Street Law Driving School graduate taking the Skills test is \$60.
4. The fee for a test prep with the Skills exam together \$130.
5. The fee for a Street Law Driving School graduate test prep with the Skills exam together \$100.

***These fees are separate from the fee charged for your Traffic Safety Course and Washington State application & licensing fees ***

6. The Knowledge exam consists of 40 multiple-choice questions. Applicants must pass the knowledge test with a score of least 80%.
7. The skills exam will test the applicants' ability to drive legally and safely. Applicants must pass the skills exam with a score of at least 80%.
8. Your exam scores will be entered into the Department of Licensing's (DOL) database within 24 hours. You will have to visit the DOL office to apply for your license. Passing the knowledge and drive test does not guarantee that an applicant will be issued a driver's license. The DOL will determine if an applicant has met all licensing requirements. If you are under the age of 18 and you wish to apply to obtain a driver's license, you must be at least 16 years old, have successfully completed a traffic safety education course, have had your permit for at least 6 months, and have had at least 50 hours of driving experience with at least 10 of those 50 hours of driving experience at night.
9. The DOL reserves the right to conduct random re-examinations; applicants refusing to take a re-examination may have their license revoked.
10. All exams are non-refundable.
11. For re-scheduling purposes, sign up for available time slot via our online scheduling system.
12. If there are any grievances/complaints, email our customer service department at mrsreetlaw@gmail.com.
13. We reserve the right to refuse services to anyone.
14. If you received a letter from the DOL to take an examination due to a physical, mental, visual or any medical issue, you must test at a DOL office. Failure to disclose this information prior to testing will result in your test not being honored at DOL to obtain your license and we will not refund the test fee.
15. All skills exams will be conducted in the Street Law Driving School vehicle.
16. You will need to demonstrate arm signals prior to beginning the skills exam.
17. Pursuant to RCW 46.20.720 a driver convicted of an alcohol offense may be required to have an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) in order to drive. This applicant must take test at another testing location, we only use the Street Law Driving School vehicle to conduct skills test.
18. At the time of the test, provide proof of identification such as a photo permit, out of state license, or passport, photo permit, or birth certificate with a photo ID.
19. At the time of the exam there are no electronic devices allowed while testing including cell phones or even translators. Also no assistance, help or interpreting will be provided by the examiner or anyone else, except by a certified interpreter which will provided by the exam applicant. This person must be DOL approved.
